SUBJECT: Justification for the Use of Social Security Number (SSN) – Defense Civilian Pay System (DCPS), **SORN T7335**, Last PIA dated 11 October 2012.

The program mission of DCPS is to process payroll for Federal appropriated fund civilian employees in accordance with existing regulatory, statutory and financial information requirements relating to civilian pay entitlement and applicable policies and procedures. DCPS provides standard interface support to the various accounting, financial and personnel systems and supports approximately 1.2 million civilian employees worldwide.

The justification for use of SSN for DCPS is based on compliancy with DoDI 1000.30 and is threefold; 1) DoDI 1000.30, Enclosure 2, Paragraph 2.c (4) “Interactions with Financial Institutions”, 2) DoDI 1000.30, Enclosure 2, Paragraph 2.c (7) “Federal Tax Payer Identification Number”, and 3) DoDI 1000.30, Enclosure 2, Paragraph 2.c (8) Computer Matching, necessary for the reports as annotated on the attached SSN Report Inventory Justified Rules listing.

DCPS is not able to transition to another identifier due to the interfaces with many legacy systems still using the SSN. The reprogramming necessary to change the key data field is cost and time prohibitive.

To ensure adequate protection and unnecessary use of Personally Identifiable Information (PII), DFAS removes or masks SSN’s on identified DCPS reports. When masking is used the employee’s SSN is hidden and displayed as XXX-XX-XXXX. The Leave and Earning Statement (LES) masks the first five numbers of the SSN and displays the last four, for example XXX-XX-1234.
