The purpose of ABCD is to deliver interactive, self-service tools utilizing various methods of submitting/accessing customer information through a web-based interface and/or automated systems that process manual financial transactions through incorporation of business rules' engines and streamlined workflows.					
The types of PII include birth date, Department of Defense (DoD) identification (ID) number, education information, financial information, gender/gender identification, home/cell phone, law enforcement information, mailing/home address, marital status, military records, name(s), official duty address, official duty telephone phone, place of birth, rank/grade, Social Security Numbers (SSN), and work e-mail address.
