

NOTICE TO STATE AGENCY

RE: HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES (HHS) INFORMATION MEMORANDUM IM-02-05, DATED SEPTEMBER 27, 2002

As previously provided in our August 28, 2018, correspondence, effective August 1, 2018, the Defense Finance and Accounting Service (DFAS) no longer processes wage verification requests related to Active Duty, Reserve/National Guard, Retired or Department of Defense (DoD) civilian personnel.

This information is available through the quarterly wage reporting that is forwarded to the HHS, which is interfaced into the Federal Parent Locator System (FPLS) and National Directory of New Hires (NDNH). All states have access to this information.

The quarterly information the DoD provides to the Health and Human Services is current and contains wages, employee address, as well as employer name and address.
