All tours incur a DFAS PFI Recruiting and Placement admin fee per position order filled. Service and admin fees will be on separate MIPRs as they are deposited into different accounts.
- FCR rates incorporate tour service reimbursement to MILPERS cost as well as the Medicare-Eligible Retiree Health Care (MERHC) fee. Annual FY25 rate for MERHC is \$6,951.00 per service member. MILPERS reimbursement and MERHC will be included as separate line items on one MIPR or 7600b to the Service Budget Office (SBO). FMS rates include annual Defense Health Program acceleration fee of \$12,695.00. Service, acceleration, and admin fees will be broken out to separate MIPRs or 7600b's. This is necessary as funds are deposited into separate accounts under different agency authorities.

FY25 will begin with legacy DD 448 MIPRs and will to transition to FS 7600b's / G-Invoicing process aligned with Service Budget Office guidance.
